The McHenry County Historical Society is sponsoring the 2nd Annual "Rock Around the Quilted Tree" Contest & Show. The show is located in the Society Museum and will run from December 2 thru Jan. 5, 2018 and is open to the public Tuesday through Friday from 1 to 4 p.m. (Closed Dec. 22-25 & Dec. 29-Jan.1) Admission \$5/\$3 seniors; members free. There are prizes and ribbons for five categories and a Just for Show category without judging. The quilts will be safely displayed as holiday trees and the wall quilts hung around the exhibit. The museum is gaily decorated with vintage holiday decorations graciously provided by Dave Harms and Lynne Eltrevoog, master Christmas collectors.

The Historical Society has an extensive history of supporting the art of quilting in McHenry County and we hope quilters will have fun seeing their personal quilts on display during the holiday season.

Prizes for Categories 1-5: 1st Place Ribbon 2nd Place Ribbon

Judge's Choice Show Champion (From Categories 1-5): A Bountiful Basket + Ribbon

People's Choice by popular vote from all categories: A Bountiful Basket + Ribbon

- Show Theme: "It's a Blue Christmas" All quilts (except Heirloom Category) must be predominately blue, and can have holiday or seasonal motifs.
- First 25 bed size quilt entries will be displayed as quilted trees.
- Quilt Competition open to all quilt makers.
- No more than two (2) entries per category and no more than three (3) total entries will be accepted from any one person.
- Quilts must be clean and in show condition.
- Owner's name should be pinned or attached to the quilt.
- Quilts must be available from Nov. 28 Jan. 10, 2018
- Each entry requires a separate entry form and \$10 entry fee. Cash, checks or credit card acceptable. Entry fee is non-refundable.
- Quilts and/or persons who made them may be photographed for promotional purposes.
- All decisions by the judge are final and the judge reserves the right to reject or reclassify any entry.
- McHenry County Historical Society will take reasonable measures to protect the materials in the exhibit, but shall assume no responsibility for loss or damage. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, MCHS assumes they have the right to photograph loaned items for record keeping, publicity and historical purposes.
- Quilts, prizes and ribbons must be picked up Jan. 10, 2018 between 1 and 5 p.m. Arrangements can be made to accommodate working quilters.
